The language of delivery for Mathematics and Sciences will be English

In continuity with the ESC practice:

Art, Music, ICT, PE, Economics and Latin\* will be taught through English  
The model to be used is that of an English section with SWALS



SWALS = students without a language section

SWALS continue to follow their current (ESC) L1

They have the section language, English, as L2

L3 and (optionally) L4 will be from French, German, Italian, Spanish

All other subjects are in the language of the section, English

Students in the regular English section:

They have English as L1

L2, Geography, History (Human Sciences) all in French or all in German

L3 and (optionally) L4 will be from French, German, Italian, Spanish

All other subjects are in the language of the section, i.e. English

There is a difference in the way age ranges are calculated between the European Schools and UK schools:

Students joining from the ESC will enter the year group they would have entered had they continued in a traditional European School

Those joining later will follow the table of equivalence which for the UK gives:  
N1 = Rec, N2 = Y1, P1 = Y2, ..., P5 = Y6, S1 = Y7, ... S7 = Y13
