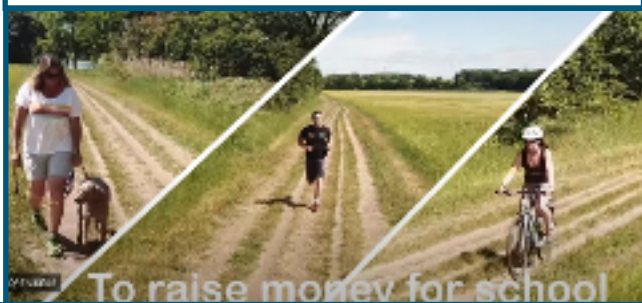


Move with Europa

Saltwater crocodile



Where do they live?

They live in the tropics, in the warm, wet, marshy areas of the world.

When do they live?

They are active at night, but also during the day. They are active in the water, on land, and in the air.

What do they eat?

- They are the largest living crocodile on earth.
- Crocodiles have a very long neck and can close their mouth so an alligator can't open its mouth.
- They also have the most important characteristics of the crocodiles.

They have the strongest bite in the animal kingdom.

Crocodiles are very gentle animals with their babies and can carry the eggs and babies in their mouths with their teeth.

Crocodiles live most of the year in the water, but

They live on land for a few weeks in the dry season.



Reproduction

- They have a long, short, and thick tail.
- Up to 3m long and 1,000 kg.
