It took considerable patience for some who had to wait 7 weeks (until A' Level results) to hear from universities whose admissions services were quite overwhelmed this year.

But the European Baccalaureate has served our students very well ultimately and their dedication and hard work has been rewarded with 90% of applicants achieving places at their Firm (preferred) Choice university (including both UK and continental applications), 5% taking up their Insurance Choice and 5% making late adjustments or new applications through clearing.
