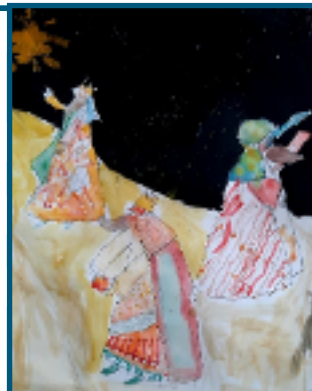
2DE working together
