Rugby for sec. 1 – 4 on Wednesdays from 1.30 – 3.30 p.m.

Table Tennis will be replaced by Rugby on Wednesdays and the coach for this activity will be none other than Richard Anstis, known to many of you for his love of an oval ball. For a great number of years Richard coached Rugby for pupils from the European School and he is now offering to carry on the tradition for pupils from the Europa School. Whether you are totally new to Rugby or have played for years, male or female, large or small, fast or slow, this course will aim to be fun and educational, developing specific skills as well as more widely applicable strategic understanding and teamwork. There may be optional matches too, so please provide an email address at the first session. There will be 10 two-hour-sessions, starting on Wednesday, 10th January, 2018 and they will take place onsite (big Sports Field). Minimum number 10, maximum number 30.

Debating workshop for sec. 4 - 7 on Saturdays from 2.00 – 4.30 p.m.

Good arguments can change minds and history and also yield more informed and considered views and decisions. This workshop will allow you to practise argumentation and debate, which are transferable skills in any communication situation, such as interviews. If you are interested in exploring and weighing ideas about big and important topics and in learning to construct an argument and to express your views with confidence, this is the course for you. You will challenge your own thinking, question prejudices, learn to listen carefully and anticipate counter-arguments.

There will be six 2.5 hour-sessions, starting on Saturday, 6th January, 2018. The workshops will take place at St. Hilda's College, Cowley Place, Oxford OX4 1DY, Hall Building, Room 55. At the helm will be Petra Schleiter and Susanne Herrmann-Sinai, both experts in their field and also parents of pupils at the Europa School. Maximum number 10.
