Please hand in your works of art to the Reception for the attention of Mrs Wood before Thursday 6th December 2018.

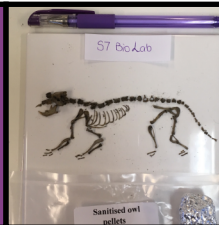

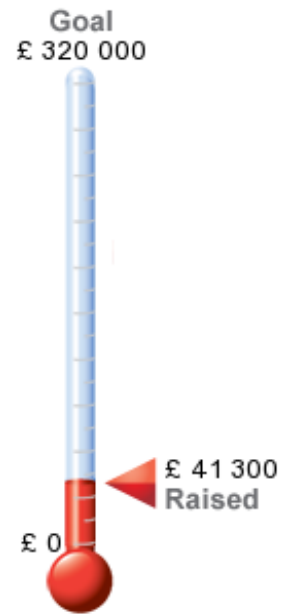
