## S5 London trip- The Bank of England & The Crystal



Learning about the financial system and how the work of the Bank affects us was an eye opener for all of us. Travelling further east by boat and cable car we reached The Crystal in the Royal Docklands - one of the world's most sustainable buildings. We learned about what it takes to develop sustainable cities and saw a large, interactive model of the docks and the surrounding areas of London of the future.

The government is currently investing £300m into the redevelopment of these areas - introducing houses, offices and infrastructure.

When developing and building cities, it is vital to make them sustainable and eco-friendly (renewable energy sources, public transport etc.), so they can serve as a living space for many generations to come.
