Mobile phones - mobile phone use is not allowed on the school site, apart from in the school reception. This includes the bus bay at the end of the day.

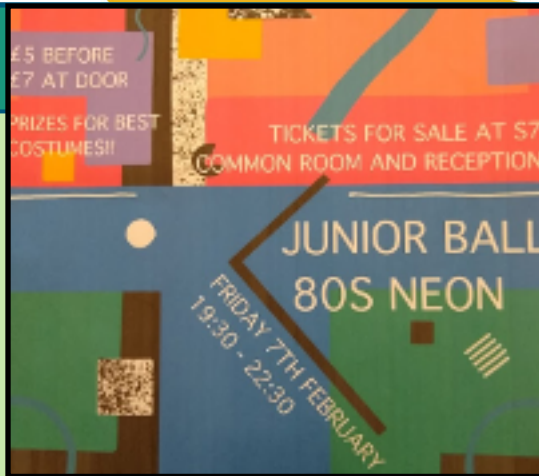
Photos - As bored as me reading about school photos? Then please come to reception and check there are none of yours, so we can stop writing about them.
