S2 project week - 22-26 June, details to follow

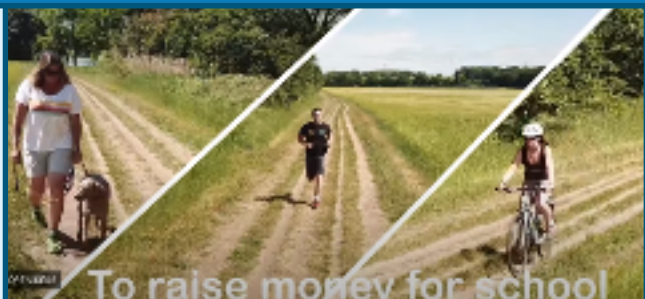
Testing team in school

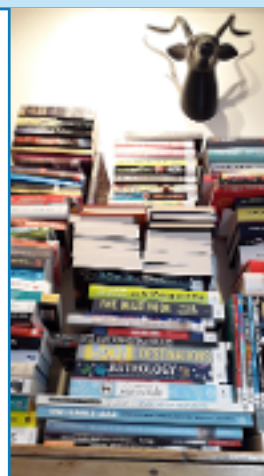
