Transmission of Covid-19 when entering and leaving the Art department	High	Moderate / High	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Pupils arriving to lessons wait outside the Art rooms to be let in by the teacher ● Students will be asked to wash hands before and after art lesson ● Increased cleaning of arts facilities will be carried out. 	Low	Moderate
Transmission of Covid-19 when in Art lessons	High	Moderate / High	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Whenever possible, Art lessons will take place outside. ● Where possible, separate equipment for each art group will be used, stored in separate trays. ● When equipment is to be used by another group it will be kept aside for at least 3 days or cleaned using anti-viral spray/wipes ● Students will be encouraged to bring in frequently used equipment – pencil, scissors, rubber ● No sharing of equipment will be allowed. ● Teachers will set rules for safe art lessons at start of the term ● At end of lesson, tables tops and chairs and sink areas will be wiped down by teacher or students supervised by teacher ● All classes will have sufficient supplies of cleaning and PPE equipment. The stock will be monitored frequently. 	Low	Moderate
Transmission of Covid-19 when using Art equipment	High	Moderate / High	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● equipment will be cleaned after use by students supervised by the teacher using recommended products (antiviral spray/wipes) ● students will keep their art sketchbook at home and bring in for lessons ● a group folder will be used to store large pieces of work 	Low	Moderate
