Transmission of Covid-19 when entering and leaving the music department	High	Moderate/High	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Pupils arriving to lessons wait outside the music block to be let in by the teacher 	Low	Moderate
Transmission of Covid-19 when in music lessons	High	Moderate/High	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Whenever possible, music lessons will alternate between the 2 music rooms, which will allow for different activities to take place 	Low	Moderate
Transmission of Covid-19 when using musical keyboards and headphones	High	Moderate/High	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Pupils will have an allocated keyboard which only they are allowed to use Keyboards will be cleaned after use by students supervised by the teacher using recommended products (antiviral spray/wipes) Students to bring their own headphones if possible 	Low	Moderate
Transmission of Covid-19 using classroom percussion	High	Moderate/High	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Each bubble (year group) will be allocated a selection of untuned percussion instruments Students to wash hands before and after using the instruments If instruments need to be used by more than one bubble consecutively, they will be cleaned after each use 	Low	Moderate

Transmission of Covid-19 whilst using computer equipment	High	Moderate/ High	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Pupils will always use the same computer ● Keyboard and mouse to be cleaned after each use ● Students to use their own headphones if possible 	Low	Moderate
Transmission of Covid-19 in peripatetic lessons	High	Moderate/ High	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Peripatetic staff members are made aware of all relevant parts of the risk assessment and have a virtual meeting prior to commencing lessons ● Peripatetic staff are given an allocated room, which meets distancing requirements for staff; wind and voice lessons to be arranged in Brahms and Spicer only ● Pupils will bring their own guitars to lessons which they will bring with them, and take away at the end of lessons ● Pupils will have an allocated seat which must not be shared with other pupils ● Pupils and staff will adhere to the guidelines for using equipment as listed above ● Peripatetic staff must remain in their allocated room for the duration of their teaching, with the exception of comfort breaks ● Peripatetic staff must not walk around the school to find pupils who do not attend lessons at their allocated time ● At least 5 minutes gap must be left between each lesson ● Peripatetic staff are welcome to continue teaching virtually in the evenings rather than attending the site should they wish to.
