Dear Parents and guardians,

Tomorrow morning (Monday 7 September) the contractors have agreed that we can open the field on Thame Lane for extra parent parking.

If you have secondary children only or secondary children who can escort their primary siblings into school then please use the field parking after 8:00. We will exceptionally look after these Primary children before 8.15.

Primary children in years 4,5 or 6 may also be dropped off in the field from 8.15 - they can escort younger siblings if you are happy with this arrangement.

Otherwise if you need to accompany your child/ren onto the school site then you must use the rear Thame Lane car park . Stagger your arrival according to the arrival time of your eldest child.

Yr 3-6 - 8:30

Yr 1&2 - 8:45

Reception - 9:00

The bus bay will be used as soon as the last bus has departed.

If you can walk or cycle with your child/ren , please do so and arrive by the front cycle gate.

Field parking Instructions

Drive through the field gate and park on your right. Marshals will be there to safely guide students across the field and through the staff car park access to the main school site.

Primary children will then be directed to the correct waiting point for their class.

Parents should remain in their cars and leave under marshal instruction.

The reason for this exceptional arrangement is due to a lack of car spaces in the rear car park following further ground work over the weekend, which will be resolved during the day. The portacabin replacement programme on the field continues this week and the contractors need exclusive access for the rest of the week to facilitate their deliveries and complete the project on time, so the field access will be a one off arrangement for tomorrow morning.

The first day afternoon pick up is also always very busy. We would be most grateful if secondary parents could arrive after 4pm to avoid the queues along the lane

Please also consider the residents of Thame Lane and drive slowly and carefully. There are pedestrians who use the lane and the verge is not wide enough for parents accompanying their young children.

Thank you for your cooperation and we look forward to seeing you all again.
