UNIVERSITY AND APPRENTICESHIP FAIR

On 16th September 2022 the S6 and S7 students and 3 staff members set off for Northampton University to the University and Apprenticeship Fair, which allowed our students to meet a host of universities, HE institutions and apprenticeship providers from all over the UK. It was an opportunity for our students to gain information and guidance so they can make the right decisions about their future.

These fairs are invaluable as they give the students the opportunity to speak to the representatives about what their University has to offer academically - different courses, pathways and admissions requirements - as well as about student life - campus facilities, sports, clubs, accommodation etc. The students could also go on a tour of the campus and therefore get a bit of a feel of what Campus University has to offer.

With over 50,000 different undergraduate degree courses available from nearly 400 providers in the UK, plus everything that is on offer from Europe - the students really do have some research to do! Discussing entry requirements with admissions officers, for the more competitive courses, also gives the student the chance to discover alternative pathways to reach their final destination.

Also on offer during the day were talks/seminars, such as student finance, choosing your course, personal statement writing and why take an apprenticeship.

We left with heads full of information and ideas, tote bags full of University prospectuses and free gifts.


