We were forced to close when the water supply to the village of Culham was unexpectedly lost, leaving us unable to use the toilets which were quickly becoming unsanitary. Once the water supply was restored we had to flush the air from our tanks and systems and clean the toilets without causing blockages.






Ask your child to read the headlines on their mobile phone and tell you which one seems more interesting or intriguing, and why.



### If you have 10 minutes

Ask them to read a short article and summarise it. Then you could ask: do you agree with what the article said? Why or why not?

## When you have 30 minutes

Choose an article and read together. Ask each other why you prefer this or that subject. Discuss what the author really meant and if your children had seen the topic in school already.
