

# Help your children to read and succeed in **Science** and Maths

# 370,000 secondary school students tested

# The link between maths, science and reading

is higher than in English literature and history

## Reading skills & science achievement

have a relationship closer than the one between interest and enjoyment of science x science achievement

### 1/4 of all 15-year-olds

have a reading age of 12 or below.

### Only 47% of boys aged 15

against 53% of girls in the same age have a reading age of 15 and higher.

### Being literate

is the most essential factor for disadvantaged students studying science.

### Have you 5 minutes?

Ask your child to read the headlines on their mobile phone and tell you which one seems more interesting or intriguing, and why.



Have we found the 'animal origin of Covid?

### If you have 10 minutes

Ask them to read a short article and summarise it. Then you could ask: do you agree with what the article said? Why or why not?



### When you have 30 minutes

Choose an article and read together. Ask each other why you prefer this or that subject. Discuss what the author really meant and if your children had seen the topic in school already.


