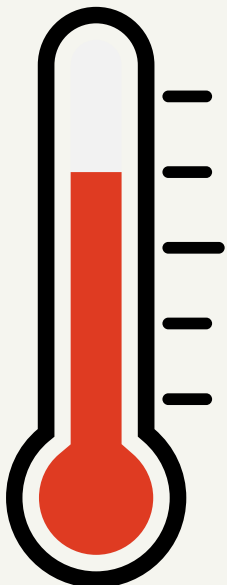
Europa School UK has worked hard to convert spaces into classrooms for the growing school, as well as creating new dedicated specialist spaces, including the design lab and mediatheque.



New Primary 8 Class Block

The DfE has promised to build a new 8 class primary block to replace the huts by the tennis courts. This has been delayed but a new contractor has now been awarded the contract for a traditional build and the design work starts in April with completion expected 2026.
