School dress code

There is no uniform at the Europa School UK. However, all students are expected to dress sensibly and comfortably for the weather and activities and to be ready for learning.

In doing so, the following guidelines are to be adhered to:

- Shorts, skirts, and dresses should be of at least mid-thigh length otherwise they must be worn with leggings.

The following items are prohibited:

- See-through clothing, for example see-through shirts;
- Strapless, 'string-strapped' or vest tops;
- Clothing which is revealing; for example, exposing bare midriffs;
- Clothing which reveals underwear;
- Gym / lycra shorts;
- Clothing with offensive logos;
- Jewellery and long nails which are considered dangerous in practical subjects.

PE kit if worn to school such as gym shorts should be worn underneath leggings or trousers.

It is recognised that this dress code will not cover all issues that may arise. Students may seek to wear, for example, items which have not been covered by the above guidelines, but which are against the tenor of the dress code. In such a case, or given any issue of dispute, the final arbiter is the Headteacher or other senior members of staff.

All students are expected to arrive at school wearing clothing in accordance with this



code. Should they not do so, then they will be given suitable clothing to continue learning throughout the day.
