The 16 to 19 Tuition Fund for the 2023 to 2024 academic year

Europa School UK is eligible to receive £1364 from this fund for small group tuition. A small group should be no more than five students for this purpose but in exceptional circumstances this may be extended to 7 students

Description of Support

The school has as its end qualification the International Baccalaureate Diploma Programme. Success in their level 3 qualification in English and Mathematics is therefore required for them to achieve the required standard in these subjects.

The 16-19 funding will provide Mathematics and English small group tuition in year 13 in the Spring 2024 to support students consolidating their learning.

50 group sessions of 1 hour duration are planned to be delivered from January 2023 to April 2024 in year 13 for English Language and Mathematics tuition. All students are working toward a level 4 qualification in the IB diploma programme.

The maximum group size is 5 students.

The students were identified from:

- Students from vulnerable groups
- Students receiving Pupil Premium.
- Students on the SEN register
- Students who did not obtain a level 4 at GCSE in English Language and/or Mathematics.
