Curriculum Stability



- Unique, distinctive primary curriculum centred on bilingual learning
- Secondary International Baccalaureate world school
 - ➤ Middle years programme offering GCSE equivalents (broad curriculum with 12 subjects)
 - ➤ Diploma Programme in sixth form (including English, Mathematics, Language, Science and Humanities)



Academic Achievements Across the School

KS2

72% pupils attained expected standard in reading, writing and mathematics compared with 59% nationally

BAC (IB)

99% pass mark with average grade of 35. 55% of higher-level entries equivalent to A*/A over two years

KS1

91% passed phonics test by end of year 2 (87% nationally)

Reception:

70% achieved expected learning goals

GCSEs

-88% gained a pass in English and maths (68% nationally), 70% a strong pass (50% nationally)

School Funding




- Funding has been a long-term issue this has benefited from the new funding formula but impacted by high inflation, unfunded pay rises and higher utility costs.
- Europa is a new school, so it has less reserves built up for the little extras and improvement projects.
- Europa is not funded for the predictable growth of one class to complete a 3-form school because of the default lagged model of funding.



School Funding Info



- Minimum per pupil funding guaranteed by New Funding Formula
 - ➤ Primary £4,296
 - > KS3 £5,602
 - > KS4 £6,219
 - > KS5 £4,972
- Approximate fees for local private schools
 - > Primary between £12 & 19K
 - ➤ Secondary £21.5K





Non-funding issue



- The lagged funding in 2023-24 created a shortfall in funding of £162K about 4% of school's income.
- Despite this we know our long-term financial model is viable and sustainable because of the financial projections performed.
