



How we Deal with Positive Covid Test Results

Europa School UK will investigate all the contacts for each confirmed case of COVID and work with PHE, OCC and DfE where required.

If you or anyone in your family has tested positive for COVID

If you or anyone in your family has tested positive for COVID please contact absences@europaschool.uk, immediately, we are constantly monitoring this email (evenings/ weekends and holidays). We will need detailed information to be able to alert relevant parties to any exposure. If possible, please contact the school before sharing it via other methods to ensure that we do not create panic.

Who will we contact?

Europa will only contact people who we believe have been exposed to the positive case whilst they were infectious (in most cases it is 48 hours before symptoms began or a positive test result if the case is asymptomatic). We will endeavour to contact anyone affected within 3 hours of receiving the information. However, in some cases dealing with the PHE and the DfE and also conducting thorough contact tracing can take longer.

If we do not contact you but you think you have been exposed or if you have information which you think is relevant for contact tracing please contact us at absences@europasschool.uk and we will respond.

Who is a direct contact? *From PHE SE educational settings pack*

Direct close contacts- Direct face to face e.g. being coughed on or spoken to contact for any length of time or within <1 meter for ≥ 1 minute.

Proximity Contacts - < 2 meters for 15 minutes or more (cumulative or consecutive time period)

Travel Contacts - Close contact within a vehicle e.g. shared car journey

If we haven't contacted you

It is likely that we have assessed your child's exposure and have not contacted you as there is no elevated risk.

What to do if you have information about a case?

If you have information about a case or exposure which we may not have and which you think we should know about please contact absences@europaschool.uk.

We will only inform the school community when relevant.
