



How we Deal with Positive Covid Test Results

Europa School UK will investigate all the contacts for each confirmed case of COVID and work with PHE, OCC and DfE where required.

If you or anyone in your family has tested positive for COVID

If you or anyone in your family has tested positive for COVID please contact absence@europaschool.uk, immediately, we are constantly monitoring this email (evenings/ weekends and holidays). If possible, please contact the school before sharing it via other methods to ensure that we do not create panic.

Who will we contact?

Europa will alert groups to cases but are not required to perform the track and trace aspect of contact tracing, however, we will help to identify contacts, if we can.

Who is a direct contact? *From PHE SE educational settings pack*

Direct close contacts- Direct face to face e.g. being coughed on or spoken to contact for any length of time or within <1 meter for ≥ 1 minute.

Proximity Contacts - < 2 meters for 15 minutes or more (cumulative or consecutive time period)

Travel Contacts - Close contact within a vehicle e.g. shared car journey
