Why Culham?

Culham is small village set in a bend in the river Thames in rural Oxfordshire, 2.5 miles from Abingdon and 9 miles from central Oxford. Abingdon is a pretty market town on the banks of the river with a strong claim to be one of England's oldest towns and is surrounded by beautiful villages. Didcot, 5 miles from Europa, is growing town with excellent train links to London. The area offers a thriving cultural scene, sports clubs and facilities.
