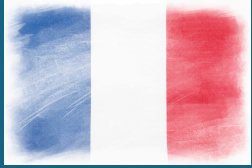

## Abingdon Museum visit: Year 3s

As part of their topic on the local area, 3EE, 3FE and 3DE recently visited the beautiful Abingdon Museum, housed in the historic old town hall. The museum workshops gave the children a fascinating insight into Abingdon's past, including life on the river, old maps, and what the area was like during the Ice Age.



The children especially enjoyed handling prehistoric flint tools, and observing a real ancient woolly mammoth task—bringing prehistory to life in a hands-on way.



On the walk back to school, the adventure continued as we passed through Culham Lock and were lucky enough to see a riverboat going through. The children were fascinated to observe the change in water levels and how the lock system works. Despite the rain, spirits were high and the day was full of learning, laughter, and exploration.
