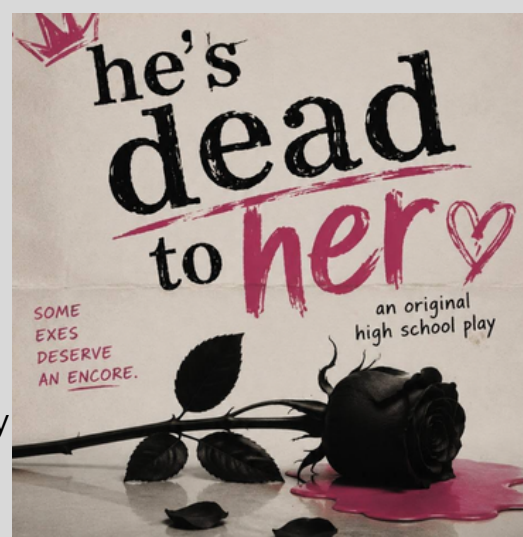
Secondary Drama Performance

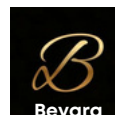
