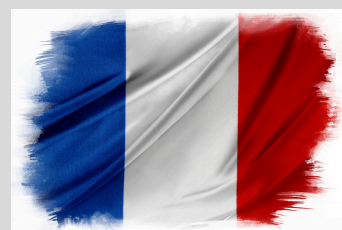

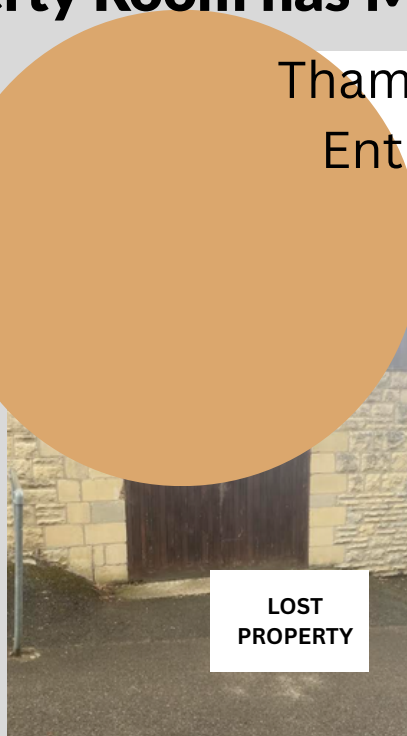
A request from 2FE: Does anyone have any games in French, like Guess Who, Cluedo, Uno that could be donated? Games for ages 6-7 years old.
