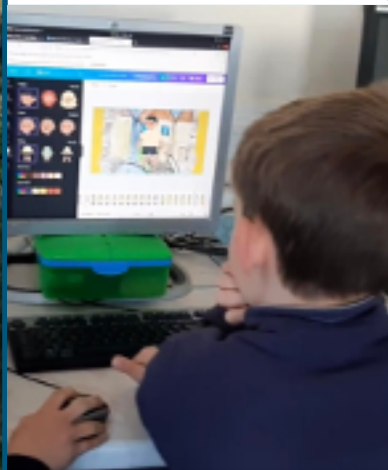
C.S Lewis Community Nature Reserve
