PTA Clothes Collection

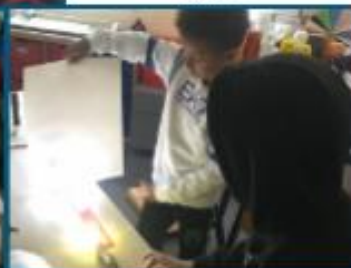
