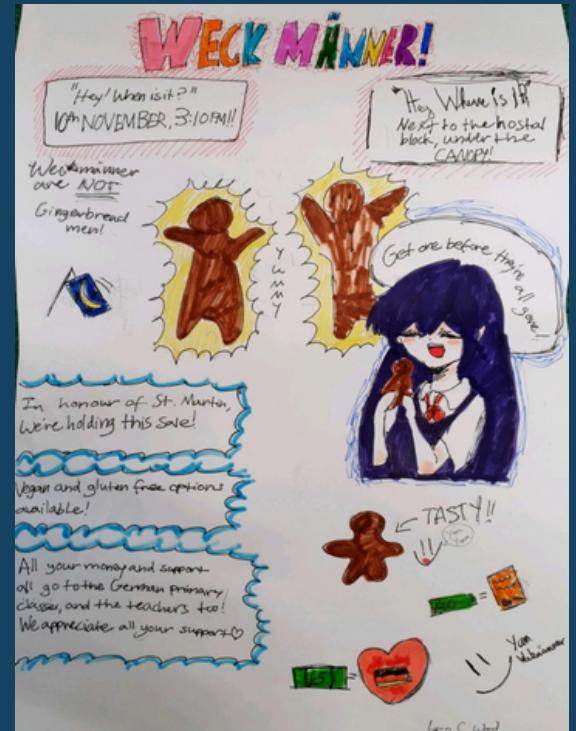

The canteen joined in with the Halloween theme too

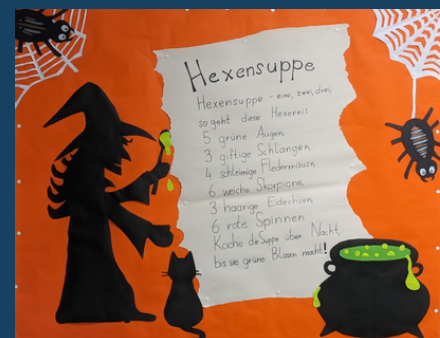
In 6EE we had a parent visit to talk about the Day of the Death in Mexico.

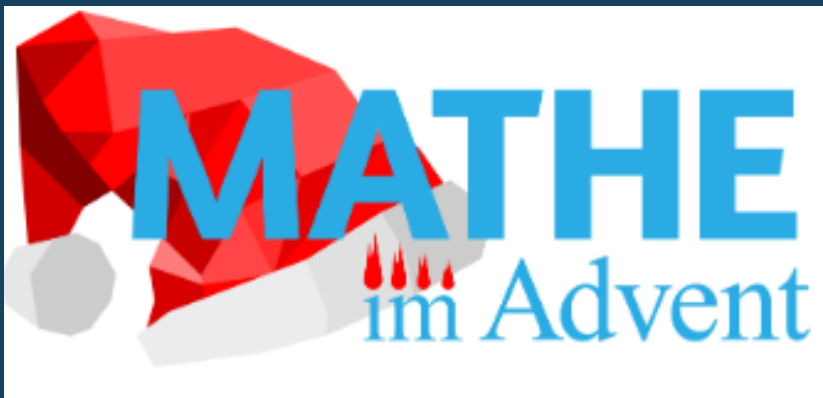
