**Deadline:**

**Artwork Requirements:**

Maximum size: **A3**

We can accept artwork in oil, acrylic, watercolour, pastel, crayon, pencil, poster paints or ink or light collage. We cannot accept any bulky collage or computer generated images.

Exhibited pictures are mounted with velcro on freestanding panels. Therefore, we can only accept artworks done on paper (ie. no boards, canvases etc.). If we feel we cannot hang an artwork due to materials used, it will be removed before judging.

**Entry Fee:**

There is a fee of **£2 per entry**.

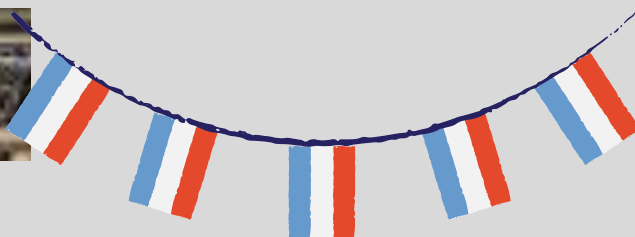


Munich Supercrew – Music Meets German Lessons at PASCH Schools
