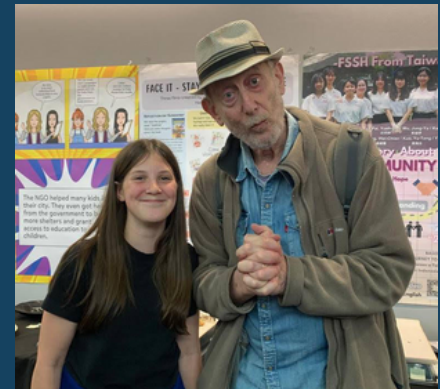
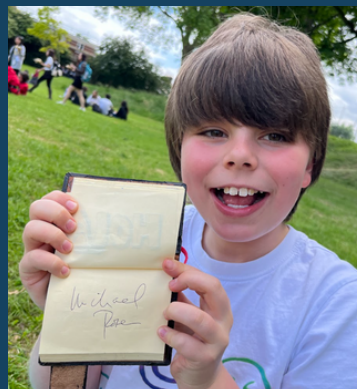
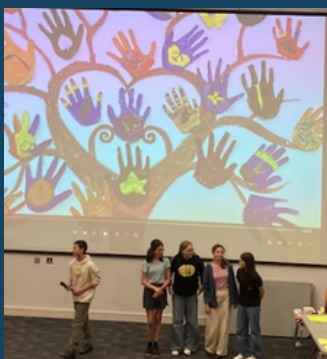
Goldsmiths University

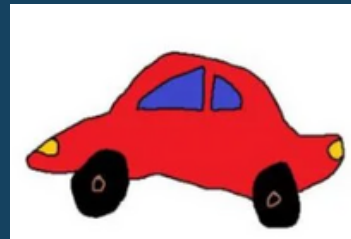


Creating books at Europa School UK

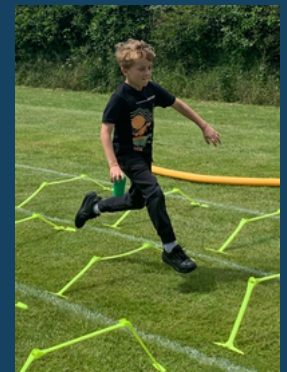


These books will be printed by a company called Saronti, a small UK-based company and the profits from it will be returned to the school for us to buy phonics and reading books for the classrooms.
