Our film is about roots of trees and our own heritage roots. Through art we explored roots in nature using charcoal, watercolour, printing, collage and sculpture. We painted pictures with language, writing haikus about tree roots with similes and metaphors. Then we discovered more about our own roots in drama, by asking our communities for stories. Our class connections spread to 26 countries! Our languages have connections between them too. We made this film using our art and poetry. We hope it will inspire you to protect roots everywhere, deep in this planet of ours!

This will include:

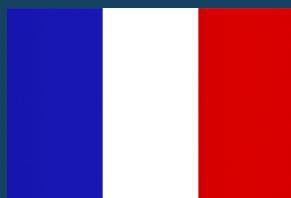
