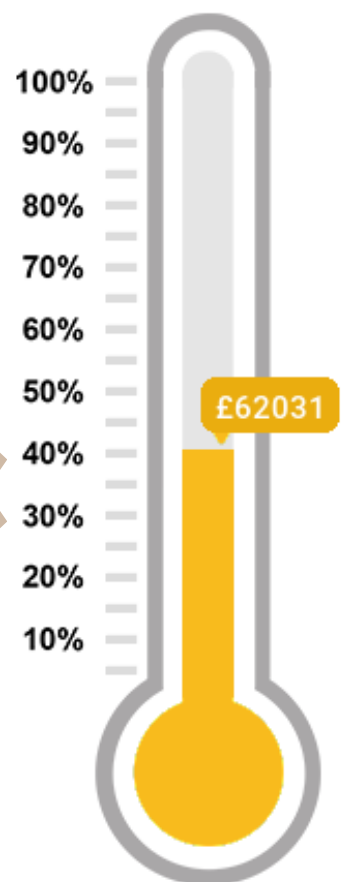

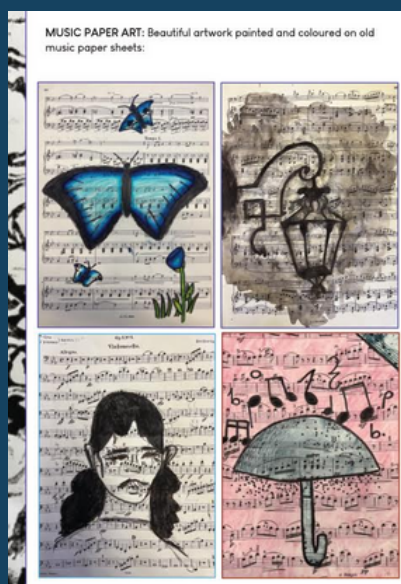

The Lost Property room will be open every Tuesday from 3pm to 4 pm. Please come and check the room when it is open for your lost items.

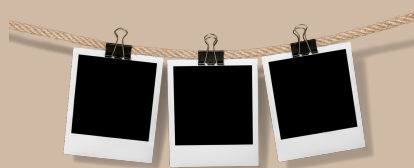
