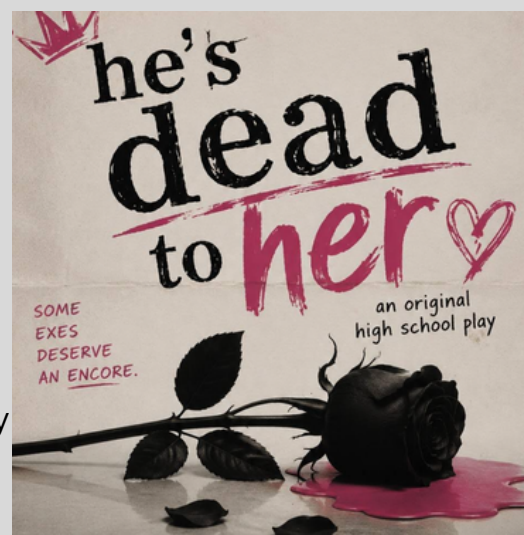
Secondary Drama Performance

We're delighted that many of the inventions the class designed have been selected and published on the Little Inventors website! Well done to all who took part.

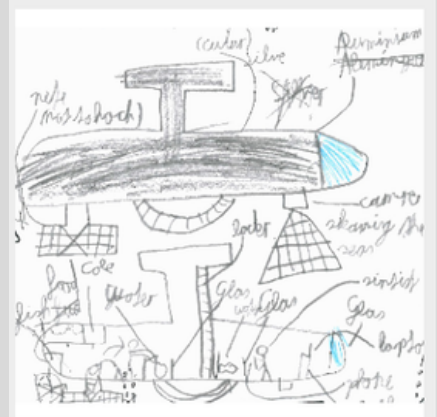

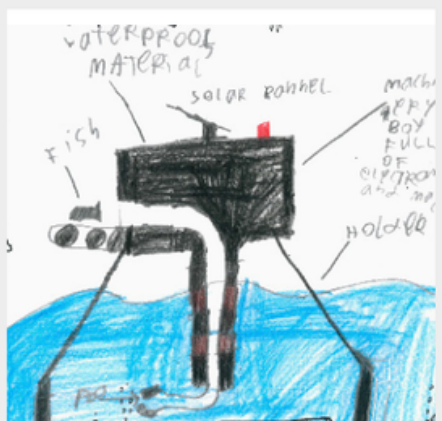

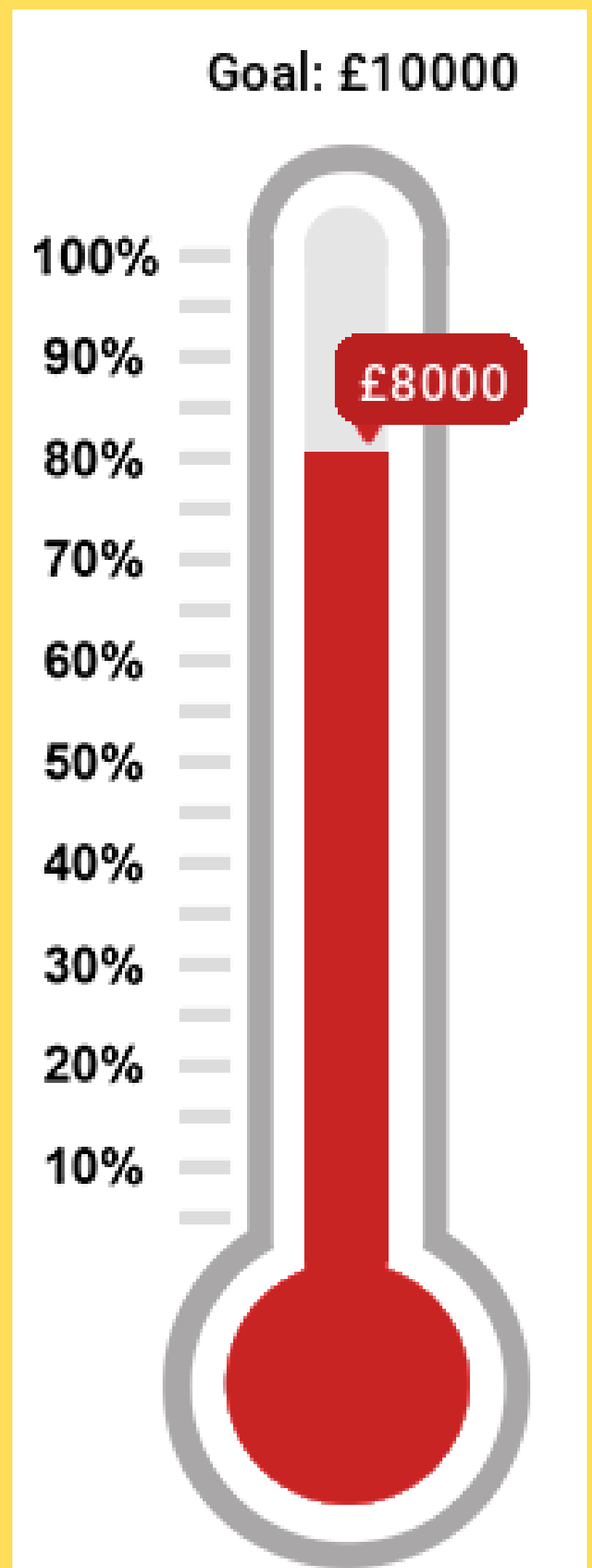
