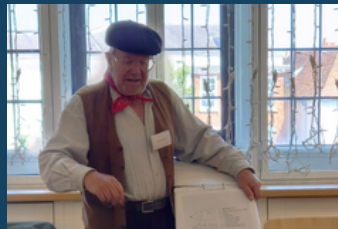

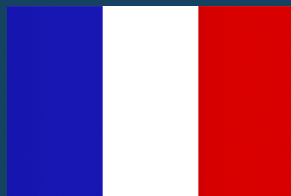


The new books we ordered thanks to the Earth Day cookie sale are now available to borrow! Thank you to the library team who have helped us!
