



Pupil Premium expenditure and impact 2020-21

In view of the small number of pupils receiving the premium, care is taken in this report not to identify individuals.

Total income from Premium: £29K for Primary and £14K for Secondary, giving a total of £43K

Total of pupils (FSM, FSM6, LAC, Service): 31 (of which 18 Primary and 13 Secondary age)

Supplementary support provided by Teaching assistants and teachers under learning support guidance
