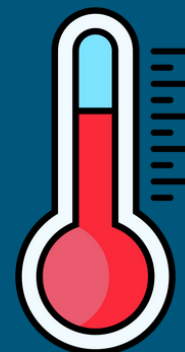


School Fund Totals

Counselling & Emotional Literacy Support

NHS statistics suggest that 20.3% – one in five – children and young people aged from eight to 16 years in England had a probable mental disorder in 2023. This a huge rise from 2017, when 12.5% had a probable mental health disorder. Europa offers support to these students:
