Quadcopter competition at Europa



Last Tuesday Europa School hosted the **Regional Finals of the quadcopter competition.**We are very proud to say that two of three teams in the final were from our school.

The students had to design and build a quadcopter to provide a service to a local hero. Our teams chose the Oxfordshire Wildlife Sanctuary (team name: Hawk Drones) and BBOWT (team name: Frogs for Logs). They were judged on their engineering skills, presentation skills and flying skills. Our teams worked really well and creatively to create two amazing quadcopters. While our quadcopters were not as beautiful as the competition's 3-D printed one, our students could say why they had made the engineering choices they had, and all three teams impressed the judges. Frogs for Logs won the obstacle course in under 4 minutes, just ahead of Hawk Drones and Bournemouth School. They'll now represent the South of England in the National Finals—well done to all the teams!

Europa's Own Sycamore Gap

During Half Term, Europa School UK sadly lost one of its most loved and historic trees, our very own "Sycamore Gap." Standing proudly on the school grounds for longer than Europa or the European School existed, this beautiful tree was a constant companion to generations of students, parents, and staff. Every year, they enjoyed the beautiful snowdrops surrounding it, which heralded the end of winter, the gentle shade it provided for the end of primary parties and the natural backdrop for the Baccalaureate proclamation photos for our Bacheliers.

During the Monday of half term, stormy weather brought down one of its four great limbs. Despite hopes that the tree might recover, the remaining sections were lost over the following days.
