Well done.





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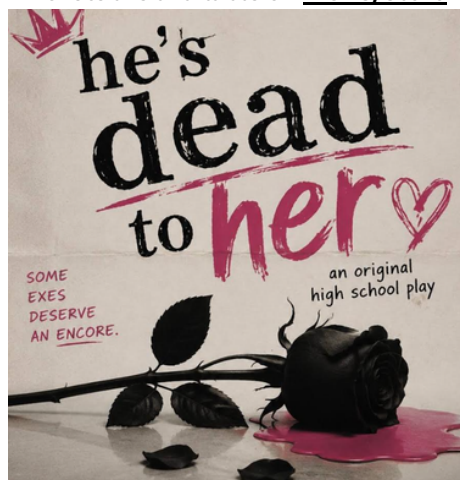

As part of the **IB Middle Years Programme (MYP)**, students are expected to complete a **Personal Project**. This is a significant independent piece of work that allows students to explore a topic they are passionate about, develop valuable research and organisational skills, and create something they can be truly proud of.

To support them along the way, we are looking for parent volunteers to become **Personal Project Supervisors**.

As a supervisor, you will mentor a small group of students, helping them stay motivated, focused and on track as they work towards their goals. You will meet with students approximately five times between September and February during school hours, provide feedback on their project draft reports and contribute to the final assessment process.

Personal Project reports are written in **English, French, German or Spanish**, and we would welcome volunteers who are able to support students in any of these languages.

This is a unique opportunity to encourage young people, celebrate their achievements and play a meaningful role in their educational journey. Many supervisors find it incredibly rewarding to see students grow in confidence, independence and resilience as they bring their ideas to life.

No previous experience is required – full training and support will be provided.

The total time commitment is approximately **3–4 hours across the academic year**, making this a manageable and highly rewarding volunteering opportunity.

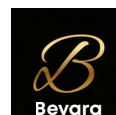

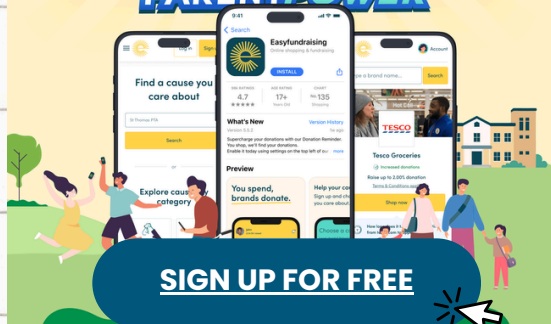
