## Intermediate Maths Challenge

Fantastic Results in the Intermediate Maths Challenge (and upcoming Junior Maths Challenge)

The Intermediate Maths Challenge is aimed at students in S3, S4 and S5 across the UK. It consists of 25 challenging and interesting problems that encourage mathematical reasoning, precision of thought and fluency and flexibility in applying mathematical techniques. A total of 101 students participated in the challenge this year, our highest number of entries ever, achieving excellent results.

## Latin club


