With an expected attendance of **more than 1,500 people over the weekend**, we would like to share some important parking and access information to help the event run as smoothly and safely as possible.

Parking Arrangements

Parking during the tournament weekend will be **charged**, and we will be using the following parking areas:

- The **field next to the Tennis Court**
- The **Thame Lane Car Park**

School Activities – Drop Off & Collection

For all regular school activities taking place during the tournament weekend, including:

- Drop off
- Collection
- Short stay parking

please use the **Bus Bay only**.

A dedicated **Parking Marshal** will be on site to guide vehicles and assist with parking arrangements safely and efficiently.

Peak Traffic Times

We kindly ask everyone to expect delays when accessing the parking areas during the following peak periods:

- **Saturday 6th June:** between **12:00pm – 1:30pm**
- **Sunday 7th June:** between **8:00am – 9:30am** and **12:00pm – 1:30pm**
