# S5 Personal Projects Exhibition

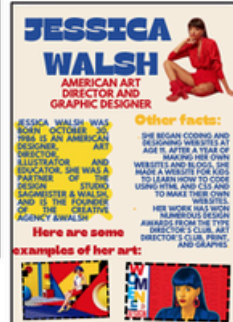
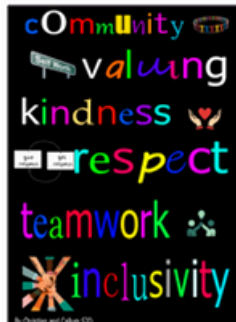

## GRAPHIC DESIGN PROJECT SCHOOL VALUES POSTERS

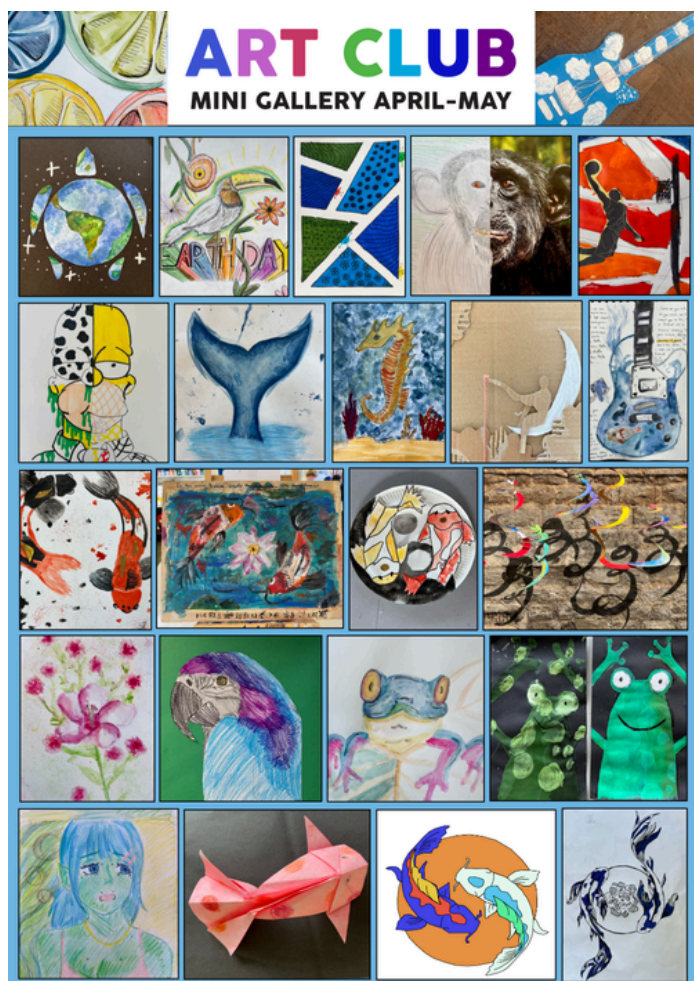
